## Unemployment and Disability returns filing only through portal

The Puerto Rico Department of Labor and Human Resources has announced the elimination of use of paper from the filing of the quarterly returns commencing with the first quarter of the tax year 2019.

As of April 1, 2019, employers must file the Unemployment and Disability Quarterly Return electronically, only through the Employers' Portal in the website of the agency.

According to the new Regulation for the Administration of the Unemployment Insurance Program (9056), the electronic return will take effect from the first quarter corresponding to the tax year 2019. Employers will have until April 30 to file and make the corresponding payment for the first quarter.
