State Unemployment and Disability Return

July 16, 2019

The Department of Labor and Human Resources (DTRH for its acronym in Spanish) of Puerto Rico, has issued a notification to remind employers that the period to file the State Unemployment and Disability Quarterly Return, expires the next Wednesday, July 31, 2019.

The new regulation for the administration of the Unemployment Insurance Program (9056), eliminates the paper form and establishes that every employer must do the filing of the quarterly return electronically not later than July 31. It also requires employers make the payment corresponding to the second contributory quarter of 2019.
