Failure to pay full amount of premiums within the specified terms, will result in the suspension of the insurance coverage. Employers may qualify for a 30-day extension of unpaid balance upon written request to the CFSE. Payments can be made by mail, using personal check, money order or certified check. In addition, payments can be made by credit card or electronic check transfer through the CFSE Portal.

For most permanent policies filed electronically on or before August 14, 2020; the first semester payment due date will be September 20, 2020. Please go to "Download Invoice" tab on the CFSE Web Portal.
